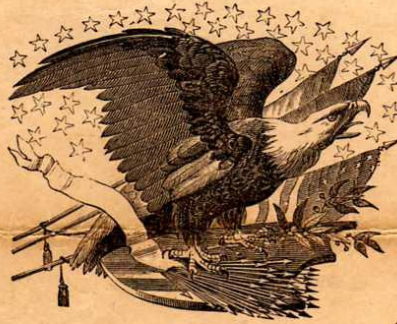

ADJUTANT GENERAL'S OFFICE. CLAIM FOR COMMUTATION OF RATIONS WHILE A PRISONER OF WAR. SETTLED.

Know ye, That *John Maucke* a Corporal of *Captain Morris Anagninski* Company, (B.) *11th* Regiment of *Connecticut Veteran* VOLUNTEERS who was enrolled on the *fourteenth* day of *December* one thousand eight hundred and *sixty* three to serve *three* years or during the war, is hereby **Discharged** from the service of the United States, this *twenty first* day of *December*, 1865, at *City Point* Virginia, by reason of *G. O. No. 131. C. S. H. No. 1. Dep. of Pa.* (No objection to his being re-enlisted is known to exist.)

Said *John Maucke* was born in *Germany* in the State of _____, is *20* years of age, *5* feet *5* inches high, *fair* complexion, *blue* eyes, *auburn* hair, and by occupation, when enrolled, a *carpenter*. Given at *City Point Va.* this *twenty first* day of *December* 1865.

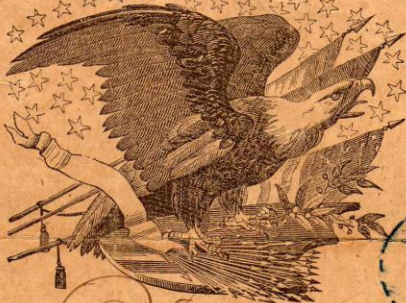

 one thousand eight hundred and sixty one to serve three years or
 during the war, is hereby **Discharged** from the service of the United States,
 this Thirteenth day of December, 1863, at Gloucester
Point Va by reason of re-enlistment as Vet Vol. under G.O. 191. War Dept. Va.
 (No objection to his being re-enlisted is known to exist.)

Said John Maucke was born in Darmstadt
 in the State of Germany, is 18 years of age,
5 feet 6 inches high, light complexion, blue eyes,
auburn hair, and by occupation, when enrolled, a Caremaker

Given at Gloucester Point Va this Thirteenth day of
December 1863.
